What is Jaguar Players?



- After school drama program
 - NOT a club
 - auditions and application is required for every production
- Open to all students 6th-8th grade
- Events may happen when dark are open to everyone

Roles as a Jaguar Player

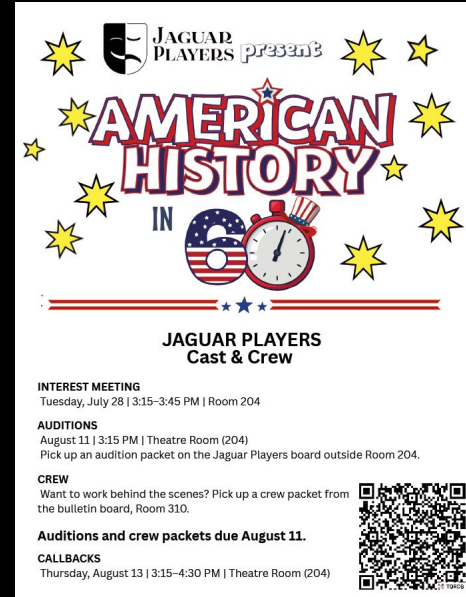
- Performers
 - Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursday and Fridays rehearsals after school- depending on schedule
 - **A full commitment is required for the entire rehearsal process.**
- Tech Crew
 - Different crew meeting on different days
 - Running Crew must be at all performances
 - Managers, Lights, Sound, some Wardrobe and Props
 - Packet includes information form, roles and responsibilities, and calendar

Actors

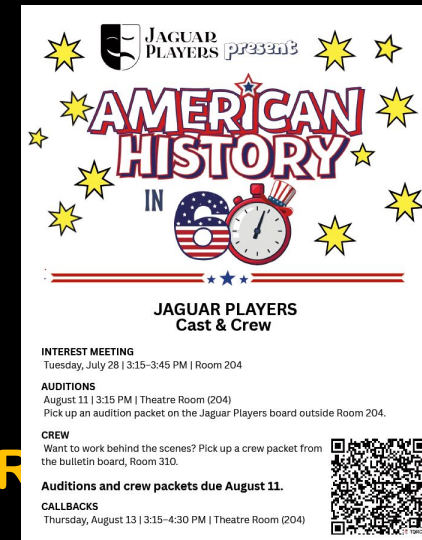
- *American History in 60*
- Performances: November 20-21
- Auditions: August 11 at 3:15pm in room 204
 - Perform the audition side from the audition packet
 - Does not need to be memorized but encouraged
- Call backs: August 13 at 3:15-4:30
 - You can still be cast if you did not get a call back
- Cast list goes online after school on August 14 by 4pm
- First rehearsal: Tuesday, August 18 (Whole cast and crew)

- Performances: November 20-21
- Tech Tour (Optional): August 4th at 3:15-4:30 in MPR
- Applications due by August 11 at 3:15pm to Jag Players bulletin boards
 - For Manager position: fill out manager AND crew form
 - Rank your choices for which department
 - Positions will be given based on applications
- Crew list goes online after school on August 14 by 4pm
- First rehearsal: Tuesday, August 18 (Whole cast and crew)



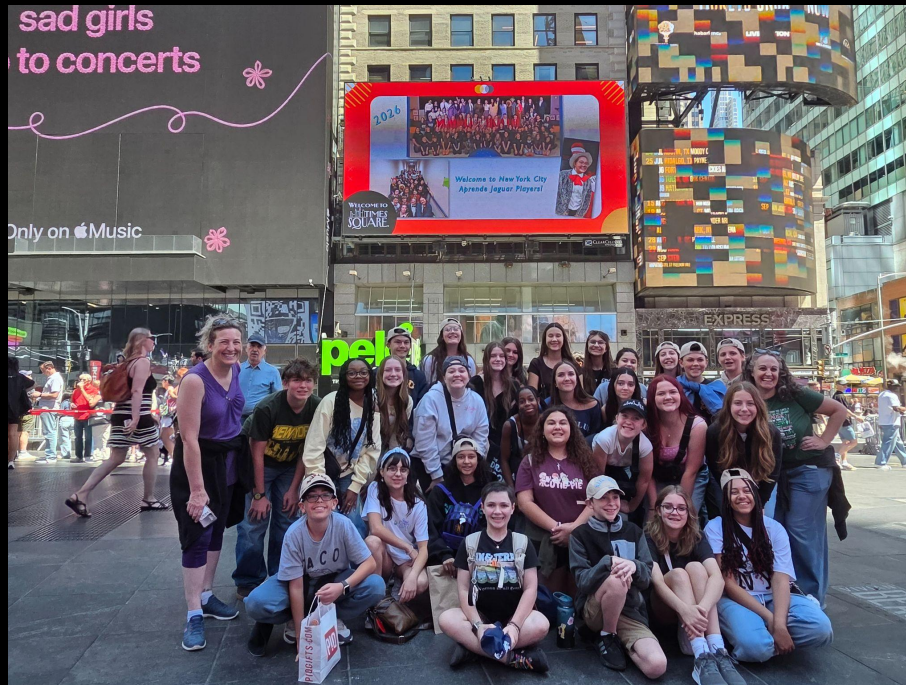
Spring Musical

- Auditions, Audition Workshop, and crew applications will be in December or beginning of January
- Performances will be the last 2 weekends in April

Where do I go from here?

- Tech Crew:
 - Pick up a Crew form (bulletin boards or QR code)
 - Come to the Tech Tour (optional) on August 4
 - Turn in form to Jag Players bulletin board outside 205/310 (parent signature required) by 3:10 on 8/11
 - Crew list will be posted on website on 8/14
- Cast Auditions:
 - Pick up an audition packet (bulletin boards or QR code)
 - Come to auditions on 8/11 in Theatre room (204)
 - Bring completed form (signature required) to auditions
 - Prepare all sides in the packet (does NOT need to be memorized)
 - You can leave when your audition is done

FAQs



- **Behavior?**

- All Jag Players are expected to adhere to school expectations at ALL times. Any conduct referrals, ISIs, or failing grades may result in your removal from Jag Players.

- **Cast or Crew?**

- Can sign up for both by the directors will assign you which role. Crew will not make final decisions until after auditions.

- **Every day?**

- Most crew and cast members will NOT meet every day. Generally 2-3 days per week but more often when it gets closer to the performances.
- We can work around most conflicts that are not mandatory if it is listed on the application/audition form.

- **Fees?**

- \$100 fee is expected (scholarships are available for those who need)
